

INVESTIGAÇÃO DE PROCESSOS EM PSICOTERAPIA. OS TERAPEUTAS DINÂMICOS USAM **TÉCNICAS COGNITIVO-COMPORTAMENTAIS?** O QUE MUDA PRIMEIRO A ESTRUTURA **OU OS SINTOMAS?**

In the first part of this conference we review the literature on process research in psychotherapy using the Psychotherapy Process Q-Set (PQS) and the Defensive Mechanism Rating Scales (DMRS). In the second part we present two recent studies. The first is about the impact of patient defenses and personality (SWAP-200) on the processes of the psychotherapy. We concluded that part of the processes used by psychoanalytic therapists, and that are considered cognitive-behavioral techniques, are in fact common factors and that the cognitive-behavioral prototype may be biased. The second is about change in structure vs symptoms (SCL-90). We conclude that symptoms change first than structure but this is mediated by patient characteristics (SWAP-200) at the beginning of the therapy.
