ADVANCED STATS: HOW TO PERFORM AND REPORT MEDIATION, MODERATION AND PLANNED CONTRAST ANALYSES

Scientific practice typically involves performing complex statistical analyses. However, performing, interpreting and describing advanced stats is not always simple for academics. Often, mediation and moderation concepts appear to be interchangeably used, and their differences are not clearly distinguished. Thus, the goal of the current seminar is to explore mediation method (Baron & Kenny, 1986) and using the bootstrapped indirect effects (Preacher & Hayes, 2004); c) test for moderation; d) plan and compute contrast analyses; and e) report results for each analysis. Because this is a hands-on seminar, participants are strongly encouraged to bring their laptops with SPSS installed, and to work on their own

mediation, moderation, and planned contrasts analyses: understanding these concepts, performing and interpreting mediation, moderation and contrast analyses using SPSS as a tool, and reporting their results. Therefore, we aim to a) clarify the differences between mediation and moderation and how to formulate hypotheses for each analysis; b) test for mediation using the traditional
